# CURAÇAO INT. AIRPORT, HATO CURAÇAO

### Project Summary

Curaçao International Airport is a fairly large facility with the second longest commercial runway in the Caribbean. Its strategic location, about 40 miles north of Venezuela, offers competitive advantages for transshipment / storage of goods and fuel supply as well as transit services for transatlantic flights to and from the Caribbean and the Latin American market in general.

The newly designed airport terminal is operational since July 1st, 2006. It is based on an initial capacity of 1.6 million passengers per year, expandable to 2.5 million passengers.

The Brazilian CCR is the majority shareholder of Curaçao Airport Partners N.V. (CAP) and holds 79% of the shares of this company (40.8% via CPA (Joint Venture with Flughafen Zürich AG 7.7% and IDC 2.6%) and 39% directly. Minority Partner with 10% is the Dutch construction group Janssen de Jong. A-port Operaciones S.A. signed an O&M-Agreement for the operation of the airport, including the right to appoint the Chief Operations Officer.

### Milestones

2003	Start of the 30-year concession, led by Alterra Partners, on August 1 <sup>st</sup>
2006	Startup of the new passenger terminal building
2009	Acquisition of the majority share from Alterra Partners by consortium of Camargo Correa, Zurich Airport and IDC (. on January 29 <sup>th</sup>
2012	Camargo Correa sells participation to CCR
2013	CCR purchase additional shares from Jansen de Jong and takes control of the concession

### Involvement of Zurich Airport

FZAG participates in the concession through its Brazilian affiliate CPA (Joint Venture with CCR) and is shareholder of the operating company A-port Operaciones S.A.
