**INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT
 HERCILIO LUZ
 FLORIANOPOLIS**

Project Summary

The Hercílio Luz International Airport, named after a former governor of Santa Catarina, was built on the site of an old Air Base. Between 1942 and 1945 the runway 03/21, apron, control tower and passenger terminal were built as well as some facilities of the Florianópolis Air Force Base and made operational. In the period between 1952 and 1954 the passenger terminal was rebuilt and was operational until 1976 when a brand-new terminal building and apron were opened. The old facility is today the cargo terminal. The new terminal was further enlarged in 1988 and 2000, reaching the present 8,703 m². In 1978 the runway 14/32 was opened allowing a great increase in traffic. In 1995 the airport was upgraded to international category and started receiving particularly seasonal flights from Argentina, Chile and Uruguay.
